# Green Wall

### PLANTING INSTRUCTIONS

**CONGRATULATIONS** on your purchase of a GLT Green wall. This installation manual will walk you through the simplicity of all planting, installing and caring for your GLT Table Top Green Wall.

## Planting Your Green Wall:

### You will need:

- GLT Stainless Steel Table Top
- One 8 quart bag of high quality growing media, preferably with moisture retention
- Waterproof drop cloth or other work area that can get soiled with growing media and moisture.
- Potted plants (2"- 4" pots). Depending on plant selection you can plant each cell or spread the plants out.
- Watering Can
- Rubber Kitchen Spatula.
- Paper Towels or similar.

**Caution:** Stainless Steel can scratch very easily.

**Caution:** The cell edges can be sharp please use caution when planting your green wall!

## 1. Irrigation Drip Pan

(has drip holes in the bottom)

## 2. Planting Cell (6" x 4")

## 3. Irrigation Catch Basin

- Both the irrigation drip pan (1) and the irrigation catch basin (3) are removable for cleaning.
- If your green wall is the stainless steel version it is dishwasher safe.
- Note the upright direction.



## Planting Instructions:

- Set up your work area to protect the floor or table from growth media and water during planting.
- Take note of which end of the green wall is up.
- Remove the irrigation drip pan (1) and the irrigation catch basin (3) (Fig. 1 & 2)

- Lay the green wall panel flat. (Fig. 3)
- Fill the green Wall panel with the high quality potting soil so that all cells are filled to the top. (Fig. 4)

- Press the soil into each cell. (Fig. 5)



- Add water until the growth media is moist. (Fig. 6)
- Add more growing media until the cells are full and moist and lightly compact again.

- Stand the green wall panel upright so that the excess water drains (5-10 minutes) (Fig. 7)

- Lay the panel back down, don't worry about excess water or growing media infiltrating the areas for the drip pan and irrigation catch basin.

- Dig a hole, with a common hand shovel (or bulb planter), in the soil large enough to fit one of the potted plants or add multiple plugs for a more mature look.

- Remove the plant from the pot making sure to pull apart any tightly bound roots at the bottom of the pot. (Fig 8 & 9)
- Insert the plant into the cell by pressing firmly around the base to compact the soil and remove any air pockets around the roots. Add moist soil as needed. (Fig. 10)

- Once all cells are filled, gently press the soil into all cells

- Once all cells are filled, stand upright and use a rubber spatula to clean the areas of the irrigation drip pan and the irrigation catch basin. The spatula will act as a squeegee then wipe any excess with a towel. (Fig. 11)

- Replace the irrigation drip pan and the irrigation catch basin.
- Pull the irrigation drip pan out half way and fill with water. Once full slide the irrigation drip pan so the face is flush with the green wall panel. (Fig. 12) Wait 30 minutes remove and empty the irrigation catch basin.

You may experience some of the growing media falling from the green wall. Once the green wall settles (24-72 hours) there will be minimal media falling and eventually the root system will stabilize the cell media.
